ADMINISTRATION> BILLING SETUP> MODIFIER DEFAULTS

### STEPS

1. Select “Add Modifier”
2. Select a percentage to increase or decrease the fee for that modifier
3. Enable “Display Alert” if applicable
4. Modifiers are now available on the modifier dropdown menu when creating claims on the CMS 1500 claim form
5. To edit an existing Modifier, select the modifier number, make your changes , and select “save”
