The WRS Development Team will perform an update on or about March 21, 2014. This release will include the following functionality as mandated by Meaningful Use Stage 2 requirements:

Patient Portal - View Summary Notes, Appointments & Requests

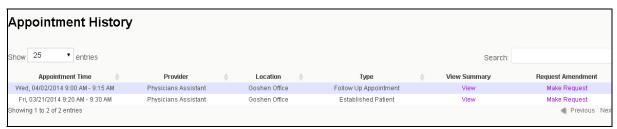
Functionality has been added to allow patients to View Notes, Appointment History, and Request Amendments to notes from the Patient Portal. These functions can be enabled/disabled by the practice (below).

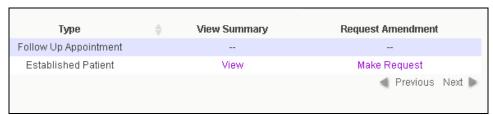
View Appointment History, Summary, Request Note Amendment

Appointment History allows patients to view a list of past and future appointments. This page also gives patients the ability to **View Summary (Note)** and **Request an Amendment** for any previous encounter.

Notes designated as **Private** by the practice <u>cannot</u> be viewed, or amended, from the **Patient Portal**. **Private Notes** are shown as "- -" and these do not display with a **View Summary** or **Request Amendment** option.



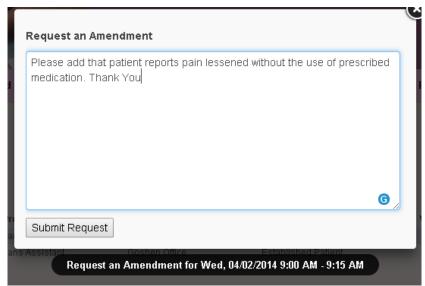

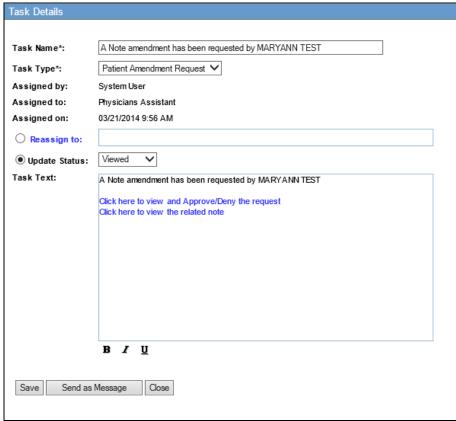
Patient Note Amendment Request

Patients can request an **Amendment** to an encounter note by selecting **Make Request** and entering a decription of the **Amendment**, pressing **Submit** to finalize:

A task is automatically created and sent to provider associated with that note. The provider task includes an option to view and Approve/Deny the request and/or view the related note.



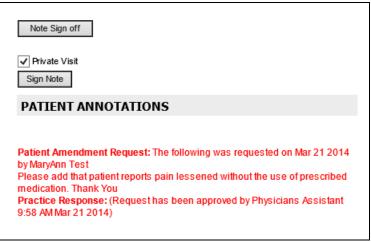
Messaging>Tasks>Patient Amendment Request (Sent to Provider)

The provider can **Approve/Deny the request** to review the amendment submitted by the patient and select **Response**: **Appove** or **Deny** to **Submit** their response.

If **Accepted** by the provider, the **Amendment** is reflected in the note (**View Note**).

If **Declined** by the provider, the note includes a notation of the **Amendment Request** and a link to the request message from the patient.

Request History

Request History allows the patient to see all requests submitted to the practice for medical record information and amendments to notes. This function is found under Patient Dashboard>Manage My Medical Record>Request History (if enabled):



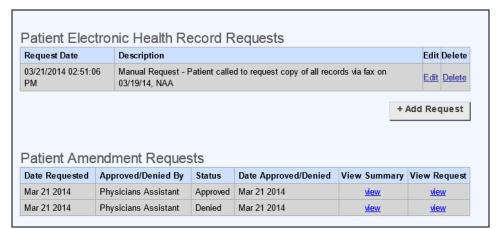

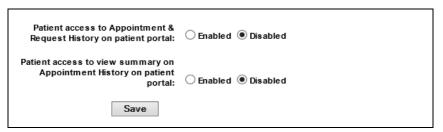

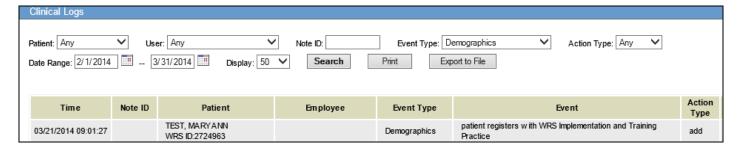
Practice Controls - Appointment & Request History

Clinical Log Enhancements

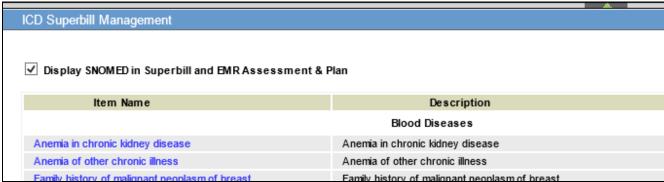
Additional functionality has been added to **Clinical Logs** under **Administration>Practice Settings>Practice Logs>Clinical Log.** The ability to filter by **Event Type** and **Action Type** has been added. Note that **Date Range** has now been limited to maximum period of 90 days:



SNOMED Coding

Ability to view and notate SNOMED coding within the Patient History and EMR Note has been added.

An option to display **SNOMED** coding on **ICD Superbill** and **Assessment & Plan** can be selected under **Administration>EMR Setup>ICD Superbill**:



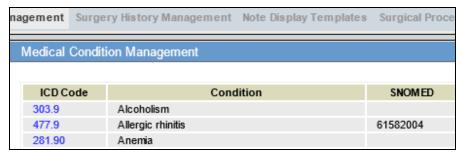

If **Display SNOMED** (above) is checked, a **SNOMED CT** section will appear on the **Assessment & Plan** page of all notes:

SNOMED coding has been added to **Family History**, **Medical History** and **Histories/Habits** pages. Also, the designation of first level relatives is now shown with a **(1)** icon:
