Re: System Update to Waiting Room Solutions

The WRS Development Team will be performing a modification to the Waiting Room Solutions System on May 15, 2010. The updated version of the system will include the following enhancements and added functionality. These have been designed to improve overall system functionality, security and usability.

Supervising Provider Prescription Tasking

All prescriptions created by staff with appropriate privileges (Rendering Providers) will be sent directly to the Supervising Provider's Task Queue for verification and approval for subsequent electronic submission. Note that Supervising and Rendering Provider relationships are setup under **Administration>Medication Setup>Supervising Prescribers**.



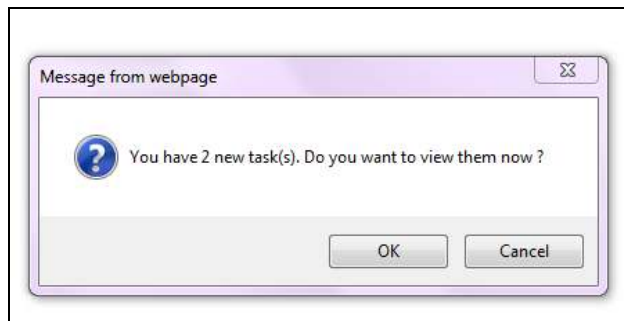
Rx created by designated staff (Rendering Provider), are sent to Supervising Provider's Task Queue for processing
