Re: System Update to Waiting Room Solutions

The WRS Development Team will be performing a software update to the Waiting Room Solutions System on or about July 01, 2011. This release will include the following:

### Addition of Multiple HPI

The ability to include multiple HPI entries and HPI templates has been added. To use this functionality, add the initial Chief Complaint and HPI. Then, apply an HPI Template:

Figure 1: EMR Note>HPI>Add New HPI

To add a second HPI, press the **Add New HPI** button. An additional HPI entry would then be added to the note.

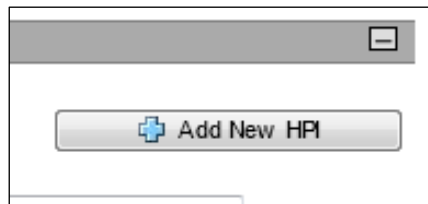


Figure 2: EMR Note>HPI Chief Complaint and Multiple HPis Added

Repeat this process for each problem to be entered.

Add New HPI

Chief complaint: cough  
 HPI Template: No template  
 HPI: 55 year-old male complains of chronic cough. Symptoms have been present for 1 weeks . Denies symptoms of sinusitis. Denies symptoms of acid reflux. Denies symptoms of allergies. Symptoms include wheezing . Has been treated by PMD with antibiotics without relief. Has history of allergic rhinitis including symptoms of sneezing . Now here for further treatment.

Chief complaint:   
 HPI Template: Tube Check  
 HPI: 55 year-old male here for follow up tube check. No complaints. Denies infections or discharge.

Chief complaint:   
 HPI Template: Vertigo Workup  
 HPI: 55 year-old male complains of symptoms of vertigo/imbalance. Symptoms have been present for 3 days . During these episodes the patient reports spinning sensation, denies tinnitus, denies hearing loss. Symptoms precipitated by: sitting down| getting up in the morning . Episodes occur constantly and last for seconds . Patient also reports other contributing factors of visual impairment . Previous treatment has included antivert . Patient reports headache.  
 Exam: Ears wnl, nose wnl, throat wnl. Cranial Nerves I-XII wnl on gross testing.  
 Vestibular Workup: Hall-Pike + , Finger-Nose + , Straight Line Test + , Romberg + , Ficara Test + .  
 Imp: Rule Out Vestibular Pathology  
 Plan: audiogram . Follow up after the above testing is completed.

Selecting **View Note** will display the note with Chief Complaint and Multiple HPIs, as entered above.

**HPI**

**1** Complaint: cough  
 HPI: 55 year-old male complains of chronic cough. Symptoms have been present for 1 weeks . Denies symptoms of sinusitis. Denies symptoms of acid reflux. Denies symptoms of allergies. **2** HPI: 55 year-old male here for follow up tube check. No complaints. Denies infections or discharge.

During these episodes the patient reports spinning sensation, denies tinnitus, denies hearing loss. Symptoms precipitated by: sitting down| getting up in the morning . Episodes occur constantly and last for seconds . Patient also reports other contributing factors of visual impairment . Previous treatment has included antivert . Patient reports headache.  
 Exam: Ears wnl, nose wnl, throat wnl. Cranial Nerves I-XII wnl on gross testing.  
 Vestibular Workup: Hall-Pike + , Finger-Nose + , Straight Line Test + , Romberg + , Ficara Test + .  
 Imp: Rule Out Vestibular Pathology  
 Plan: audiogram . Follow up after the above testing is completed.

Note that HPI Templates can be setup under **Administration>EMR Setup>HPI Templates**. Once created, templates can be copied from any practice user to another practice user:

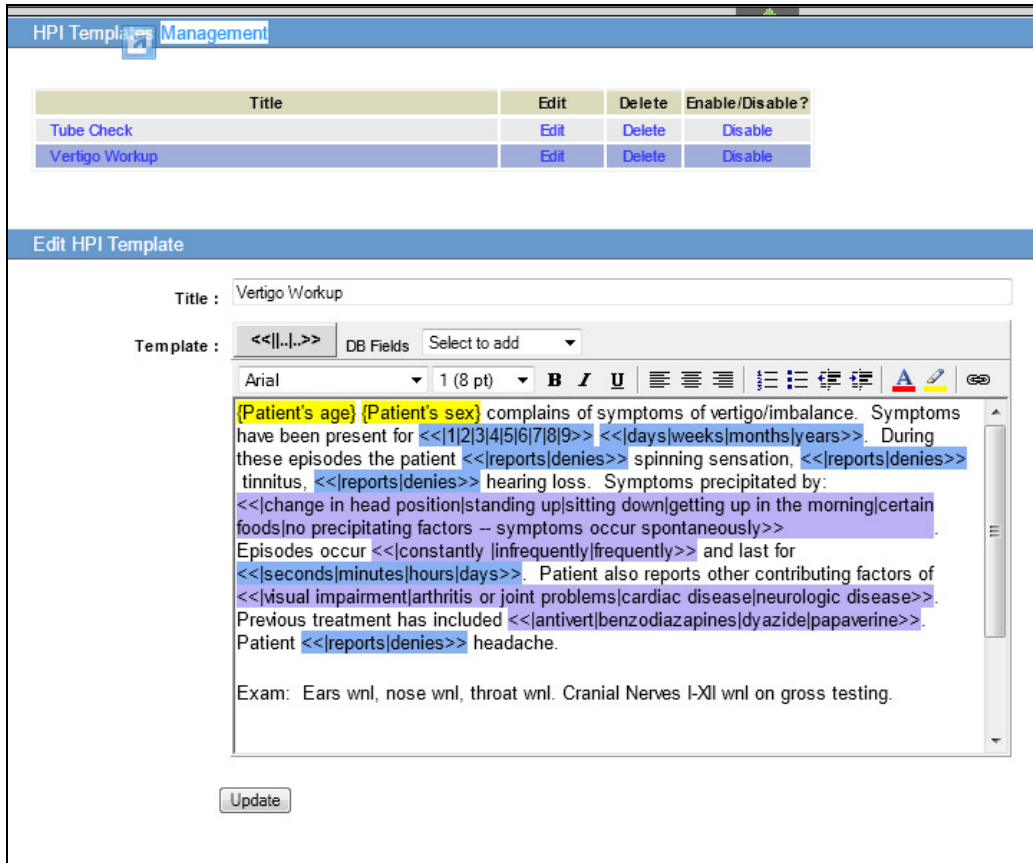


Figure 5: Administration>EMR Setup>HPI Templates
