Re: WRS Health System Update

The WRS Development Team will perform an update on or about July 18, 2014. This release will include the following functionality mandated by Meaningful Use requirements:

UPDATED MEANINGFUL USE REPORTS

Meaningful Use Reports have been updated and include all MU Program Years and Stages. The reports can be accessed under **EMR>Meaningful Use Reports> 2011 Stage 1**, **2014 Stage 1** and **2014 Stage 2**.

Note that reports are populated with data from some portions of MU2 functionality that is still forthcoming. As a result, reports will only be partially populated until the remaining MU2 functionality is released over the coming weeks.




Figure 2: EMR Note>Meaningful Use Reports>2014 Stage 2

HEALTH MAINTENANCE AND CLINICAL DECISION SUPPORT RULES

As you many know, Clinical Decision Support (CDS) Rules are a requirement for MU2. They can be useful for tracking and monitoring of patient status and as a way to alerting providers to CQMs that are tied directly to CDS Rules. Functionality has been added that will cause CDS Alerts to populate a note when data is added that relates to parameters of setup CDS Rules.

In order to view CDS Rules and info, the user must have the **Clinical Decision Support** permission enabled under **Administration>Resource Management>Resource Setup>[NAME]>Clinical Decision Support**. Note that without this permission enabled, the user will not be able to take advantage of the CDS alert functionality that is described below.

CDS alert information is shown during the **Move to Exam Room** process and under **EMR Note>Orders/Procedures Page>Show Tests Due,** as applicable.




Figure 4: CDS Alert shown during Move to Exam Room and under EMR Note>Orders/Procedures Page>Show Tests Due

Also, a new CDS Counter has been added to notes under EMR Note (left column menu)




Figure 5: CDS Counter shown under EMR Note (left column menu)

Health Maintenance Rules can be activated for CDS by selecting the **Clinical Decision Support Rule** checkbox. This is found under **Administration>Order Tracking Setup> Health Maintenance Rule Details**:




Figure 6: Administration>Order Tracking Setup> Health Maintenance Rule Details>Clinical Decision Support Rule

Health Maintenance Rules have been enhanced to better facilitate the monitoring of Vitals, for both direct medical reasons and as captured data for MU Measures and CQMs:




Figure 7: Administration>Order Tracking Setup> Health Maintenance Rule Details>Vitals

Functionality has also been added to **Vitals** area to address specific patient documentation and forms specific to many CQMs, as required for MU1 and MU2 in 2014:




Figure 8: Administration>Order Tracking Setup> Health Maintenance Rule Details>Vitals (Forms)

For practices that do not want forms accessible in their notes, these can be deactivated through **EMR SETUP>Vital Sign Management.** Pressing the **X** icon under the **Forms** section will remove these from all future EMR Notes created by the practice.




Figure 9: Administration>EMR Setup>Vital Sign Management

Functionality has been added to create new CDS Rules under **Health Maintenance>Clinical Decision Support Rules.** This gives the ability to create accompanying documentation for a rule and include a medical reference link, along with attaching the source document itself. Note that for MU2 a rule will not be counted as a numerator value, if this area is not complete. Additional educational materials, instructions and webinars will be offered to all WRS clients to address CDS Rule setup, functionality and workflow:




Figure 10: Administration>Order Tracking Setup> Health Maintenance Rule Details>

OPT OUT COMMUNICATION CONTACT

Functionality has been added to **Opt out-DO NOT SEND** automated communication to a particular patient under **Manage Patients>Contact Information>Comminication Preference**.

Under Manage Patients>Contact Information<Communication Preference, select a Communication Type (Appointment Confirmation, Appointmet Recall, Test Results,, Health Maintenance Reminders) This will remove the patient from receiving automated messages under the Communication Type that is selected.
